RULES OF ACCESS TO THE STATUE

- Children under the age of 6 are not allowed inside even if accompanied.
- Children aged 6 to 10 can enter only if accompanied by at least one parent or delegated adult aged 18 or above; the parent or delegated adult will be responsible for the behaviour of the child during ascent and descent. During ascent the adult in charge must follow the child and preced him/her during the descent; safety harnesses and helmets are provided on request.
- For their own safety pregnant women, people with physical and mobility impairments, with sight impairment or heart conditions are not allowed to climb up the statue.
- People suffering from vertigo or claustrophobia are advised against climbing up the statue.
- Backpacks, cumbersome bags or umbrellas are not allowed inside the statue.
- It is forbidden to film or take photos during the ascent and descent; cameras and video equipment must be carried close to the body.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS

Animals are not allowed in the garden or in the statue.

The waiting time to enter the statue depends on the flow (it can be more than an hour): please ask the waiting time at the ticket office before buying your ticket.

The staff is not responsible if the delay is longer than initially predicted.

If booked beforehand, groups of 20 or more people are allowed to stay in the garden during luch time.

We inform you that the area inside and around the statue is provided with an audio video recording sys-tem, in compliance with the applicable italian laws
